The Granger Township Board of Trustees met in Regular Session on Monday, July 22, 2019, 4:00 PM, at the Granger Township Administration Building, 3717 Ridge Rd., Medina. Present were Trustees: John H. Ginley, Jr., Chair, Teri A. Berry and Richard L. Pace and Fiscal Officer Donald L. Baker.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: The meeting was opened at 4:00 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance by Trustee John H. Ginley, Jr.

FIRE DEPARTMENT FIREFIGHTER SWEARING -IN: Mr. Ginley swore in new probationary Firefighters Marcus Moore, Ryan Sholtis and Matthew Sinopli. The new Firefighters were congratulated with a round of applause from the Trustees, Fiscal Officer and audience.

DEPUTY SHERIFF PRIES was present and advised there were 375 activities in the Township during June including 102 traffic stops. This has not been a typical summer and noted there had been no calls regarding loud parties.

SERVICE DEPARTMENT DIRECTOR Mark Novak reported he had made various contacts regarding the painted arrows on the road and cannot determine an explanation for them.

STATE ROAD CULVERTS: Mr. Novak discussed two culverts on State Road that were damaged because of recent heavy rainfalls. One is starting to cause a sink hole. He recommended replacing them both and increasing their sizes from thirty-six to forty-eight inches and twelve to fifteen inches. According to Mr. Novak, Dan Becker of the Medina County Engineer's office agrees with this recommendation.

A **MOTION** to replace two culverts on State Road and increasing the sizes from thirty-six to forty-eight inches and twelve to fifteen inches at a cost not to exceed \$5,000.00, was set forth and moved to be adopted by Mrs. Berry, duly seconded by Mr. Pace.

Voting "aye" thereon: Mr. Ginley, Mrs. Berry, and Mr. Pace.

APPROVAL OF THEN AND NOW PURCHASE ORDER 61-2019: Mr. Baker requested approval for Then and Now Purchase Order 61-2019 for Montrose Ford in the amount of \$1,099.96 for Brake Repair to the F550 Truck.

A **MOTION** approving Then and Now Purchase Order 61-2019 for Brake Repair to the F550 Truck by Montrose Ford in the amount of \$1,099.96, was set forth and moved to be adopted by Mr. Pace, duly seconded by Mrs. Berry.

Voting "aye" thereon: Mr. Pace, Mrs. Berry, and Mr. Ginley.

FIRE CHIEF James Paulett reported dry hydrant testing has commenced. Continued pumping problems with Engine 71-1 have been corrected and dry hydrant testing should increase in the next month. Two fire prevention programs at the Windfall building were conducted. I Am Boundless, Inc. requested a tour of the station in August. A group from Windfall has also requested a program.

Chief Paulett advised the report previously requested by Mrs. Berry will be forthcoming in the near future.

Chief Paulett requested guidance about what to charge for EMS services for non-Highland football games. Trustees opined this has been discussed in the past and he should do research on this.

HARRIS MOBILE RADIO: Chief Paulett request permission to purchase, from Cleveland Communications, one Harris mobile radio for \$3,606.00. This unit will be installed at Medina County Dispatch. The Sheriff, Sharon Township, and Hinckley Township have also been asked to purchase radios. These units will be used for improved interoperability with the MARC'S and Summit County radio systems.

A **MOTION** to approve the purchase one Harris mobile radio for \$3,606.00 from Cleveland Communications, was set forth and moved to be adopted by Mr. Pace, duly seconded by Mrs. Berry.

Voting "aye" thereon: Mr. Pace, Mrs. Berry and Mr. Ginley.

APPROVAL OF THEN AND NOW PURCHASE ORDER 62-2019: Mr. Baker requested approval for Then and Now Purchase Order 62-2019 for Parker and Trailer in the amount of \$1,280.37 for repairs to 71-1.

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A **MOTION** approving Then and Now Purchase Order 62-2019 for Repairs to 71-1 by Parker Truck and Trailer in the amount of \$1,280.37, was set forth and moved to be adopted by Mrs. Ginley, duly seconded by Mr. Pace.

Voting "aye" thereon: Mrs. Berry, Mr. Pace and Mr. Ginley.

The Chief will be on vacation July 26th through August 4th.

SEXTON: Roberta Gifford was present and reported there has been one burial and two lots sold MTD. The company doing the leveling will be in contact with Mr. Novak about getting this project started.

CEMETERY DEEDS: A Fairview Cemetery Deed (Lot No. 523, Section 16 Grave No. 5) was duly authorized and executed for Jennifer A. Ripley, 1251 Wilbur Road, Medina, OH 44256.

A Fairview Cemetery Deed (Lot No. 523, Section 16 Grave No. 6) was duly authorized and executed for Robert N. Ripley, 1251 Wilbur Road, Medina, OH 44256.

CEMETERY GRANT DISCUSSION: Mr. Baker noted he and Mrs. Gifford met to discuss the Ohio Department of Commerce Cemetery Grant and needed guidance from the Board. Should we pursue this grant for additional leveling or for monument cleaning? The Board opined it favored additional leveling. Mr. Baker requested a motion to authorize the application for this grant.

A **MOTION** to authorizing the application for the Ohio Department of Commerce Cemetery for monument leveling was set forth and moved to be adopted by Mr. Pace, duly seconded by Mr. Ginley.

Voting "aye" thereon: Mr. Pace, Mrs. Berry and Mr. Ginley.

ZONING INSPECTOR: Randal Davis reported seven applications have been taken month to date. Eight violations are currently being pursued.

BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS is scheduled to meet July 30, 2019 at 7:00 PM to consider two Variance requests for 1291 Medina Road, a Variance request 1800 Medina Line Road, three Variance requests 4762 Ridge Road and a Conditional Use request for property located on Wilbur Road.

ZONING COMMISSION is scheduled to hold a Special Meeting on August 6, 2019 at 7:30 PM to continue review of sign regulations. The Zoning Commission is also scheduled to hold its Regular Meeting on August 13, 2019 at 7:00 PM to review the final PDD Plan for Akron Medina Corporate Park.

Mr. Pace noted a letter had been received from a BZA applicant stating he can't be at the meeting of July 30th. He stated his belief that this letter was supposed to be notarized. Mr. Davis was requested to research this.

HISTORICAL SOCIETY LEASE AGREEMENT: Mr. Baker advised there were a few minor changes to the draft agreement that was previously distributed. A clause requiring a rent payment of one dollar annually was added at the request of State Historical Society and some other minor alterations were made. He recommended the Board execute the agreement.

A **MOTION** to enter into an agreement with the Granger Township Historical Society for the leasing of 1261 Granger Road for a period of ten years was set forth and moved to be adopted by Mr. Ginley duly seconded by Mr. Pace.

Voting "aye" thereon: Mr. Ginley, Mrs. Berry and Mr. Pace.

MOTION TO APPROVE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS: A **MOTION** to approve the following Supplemental Appropriations was set forth and moved to be adopted by Mr. Ginley, duly seconded by Mr. Pace.
